

Waste Free Days at the Box Moor Trust



At the Box Moor Trust, we want to minimise our impact on the environment and to educate our visitors on how they can do the same.

Look out for the signs around the Old Barn Education Centre telling you what we are doing.

We need your help!

Most of the waste produced at the Old Barn is snack and lunch waste produced by our visitors.

To reduce this, we are setting our visitors a 'Waste Free Day' Challenge.

We would be grateful if you could discuss this with your class or group prior to visiting the Box Moor Trust.



PLEASE ASK YOUR CLASS OR GROUP TO BRING REUSABLE SNACK/LUNCH/DRINK CONTAINERS.

These can be washed and used again. Minimising waste in the first place should be our priority. Any recyclable waste can be dealt with back at home using the local authority recycling scheme.



There are NO DISPOSAL FACILITIES for ANY food or drink waste at the Old Barn.

We hope that taking all of their waste home will be a valuable lesson for our visitors and encourage them to be more responsible for the waste they produce.



PLEASE ASK YOUR CLASS OR GROUP TO CARRY THEIR OWN WASTE HOME.

To ensure that items are appropriately reused, recycled or composted at home, please do not collect your class or group's waste together after snack or lunch. Remember, everything collected in your waste sack will be sent for disposal, regardless of whether it is reusable, recyclable or compostable. Instead, encourage each visitor to take responsibility by carrying their own waste home and thinking about how they can deal with it in the way that is best for the environment. If possible, please discuss what will happen to the waste produced by your class or group, either prior to your visit or during the snack or lunch break.
